Introduction

The Leys School ('the School') is committed to supporting Fairtrade wherever possible. Fairtrade is about guaranteeing a better deal for farmers in poorer countries who grow things we eat and use every day.

The School will:

- Support the Fairtrade Steering Group.
- Consider Fairtrade as part of the School Development Plan.
- Use Fairtrade produce wherever possible via Catering, School Shop and Cafe.
- Continue to use ethically certified suppliers of school uniform (David Luke and Blue Max Banner).
- Raise awareness around the school of Fairtrade products as alternatives to everyday commodities e.g. Food, drinks, clothing & domestic products
- Educate pupils about Fairtrade within the curriculum; PSHE, Geography, Economics and Business Studies already ensure this.
- Organise Fairtrade events to raise awareness.
- Utilise social media to raise awareness of Fairtrade to a wider audience.
- Raise awareness of FT within school through displays and posters around the school site.
